# Resolution 4: Removal of Missionary Offering of 5% to Network (Bylaws)

1 2 3	WHEREAS	the Network Bylaws require each missionary to send 5% of their itineration offerings to the Network to support world missionary endeavors, and
4 5	WHEREAS	many missionaries are unaware of the 5% required by the Bylaws, and
6 7 8	WHEREAS	missionaries are already asked to support the Network with the tithe required by the General Council Bylaws, and
9 10 11 12	WHEREAS	the amount received from the 5% has significantly declined and has averaged under \$4000 annually due to many churches sending their offerings directly to AGWM or AGUSM, and
13 14 15	WHEREAS	the 5% is an amount taken from their itineration offerings in addition to the 7% that the National office retains for administration, and
16 17 18	WHEREAS	missionaries would have the 5% added back into their budget to support their ministry activities,
